Perform advanced resuscitation using nasopharyngeal and laryngeal mask airways	701724D1
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Performance	Select, insert and use nasopharyngeal and laryngeal mask airways to perform resuscitation.
Standards	For at least 10 minutes, in accordance with good practices and approved references set by recognised international, national or state bodies.
Conditions	On an adult with adjuncts, oxygen and AED.
Comments	Must also include checking, maintaining and cleaning associated equipment.

Identify and describe function of human anatomy for first aid purposes	701724D2
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Performance	Identify and describe function of human anatomy for first aid purposes
Standards	In accordance with IMO Model Course 1.14 (Medical First Aid) and approved references.
Conditions	Given anatomical drawings or models.
Comments	

Package and move casualty within a shipborne environment	701724D3
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Performance	Package an person or manikin with simulated medical condition or injury and transport to a place in readiness of evacuation off a ship.
Standards	In accordance with IMO Model Course 1.14 (Medical First Aid) and approved references.
Conditions	Using blankets, chairs, ropes, and stretchers.
Comments	A range of lifts, drags and carries must be demonstrated.

Demonstrate knowledge of ships medical chest and radio medical advice	701724D4
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Performance	Recall the purpose of a ships medical chest and protocols to access or administer controlled drugs under the direction of radio medical advice.
Standards	In accordance with IMO Model Course 1.14 (Medical First Aid), ships standing orders (or similar) and approved references.
Conditions	Given ships medical chest.
Comments	Radio advice includes telehealth services provided by telephone, radio, satellite, internet call/video or electronic messenger.

Performance	Identify the purpose, security, record keeping, indications and contraindications for controlled drugs commonly found in a ships medical chest.
Standards	In accordance with IMO Model Course 1.14 (Medical First Aid), ships standing orders (or similar) and approved references.
Conditions	
Comments	May include: morphine, erythromycin, tetracycline hydrochloride, phenoxymethyl penicillin potassium, procaine benzylpenicillin, cyclizine hydrochloride, sulfamethoxazole trimethoprim.
