<b>Standards</b>	In accordance with NFPA 10, ISO 7165 or AS/NZS1850.
<b>Conditions</b>	Given a range of example of fire extinguishers for a range of fire types.

### Select suitable fire extinguisher for class of fire 700823D2

<b>Performance</b>	Select suitable fire extinguisher for class of fire.
<b>Standards</b>	In accordance with NFPA 10, ISO 7165 or AS/NZS1850.
<b>Conditions</b>	Given a range of example of fire extinguishers and range of fire types.
<b>Comments</b>	

### Carry and actuate fire extinguisher 700823D3

<b>Performance</b>	Raise alarm of fire incident, transport fire extinguisher to fire and actuate in preparation to apply extinguishing agent.
<b>Standards</b>	In accordance with NFPA 10, ISO 7165 or AS/NZS1850; and organisational emergency plan or agency doctrine.
<b>Conditions</b>	Given simulated fire within 25m of extinguisher location, using fully charged extinguisher no heavier than 20kg that is suitable for the class of fire being attacked.
<b>Comments</b>	Simulate fire must include real-life or IPSQA approved virtual reality simulator. May include pneumonics like PTASS (Pull, Test, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep).

### Apply extinguishing agent to fire and carry out post-incident actions 700823D3

<b>Performance</b>	Correctly apply extinguishing agent to control a fire and carry out post-incident actions.
<b>Standards</b>	In accordance with NFPA 10, ISO 7165 or AS/NZS1850; and organisational emergency plan or agency doctrine.
<b>Conditions</b>	Given simulated fire within 25m of extinguisher location, using fully charged extinguisher no heavier than 20kg that is suitable for the class of fire being attacked.
<b>Comments</b>	Simulate fire must include real-life or IPSQA approved virtual reality simulator. May include pneumonics like PTASS (Pull, Test, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep). Candidate must demonstrate retreat or discontinuation of fire attack. Post-incident actions may include incident reporting, debriefing, completion of logs, replacing discharged extinguishers.
